

Reply to RFP Questions Received by the Town on April 5, 2016

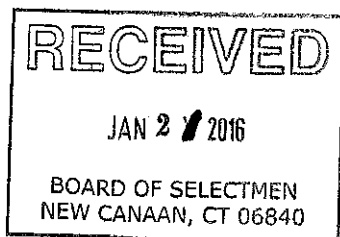

**Re: Utility Pole Attachments to be Performed by Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon
Wireless in New Canaan, Connecticut
Municipal Notification**

Dear First Selectman Mallozzi:

Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless ("Cellco") is in the process of upgrading its wireless network in New Canaan and intends to install new antennas and associated equipment on existing utility poles in public rights of way. This network upgrade project will allow Cellco to provide your community with enhanced wireless voice and data services. Federal and State law permits Cellco to implement these system upgrades following the procedure outlined below.

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes section 16-234, Cellco will provide notification of its intent to use certain utility poles to each adjoining property owner, which the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority ("Authority") has defined as any property owner within 140 feet of the utility pole to be used¹. Two examples of typical pole attachment schematics are attached for your review.

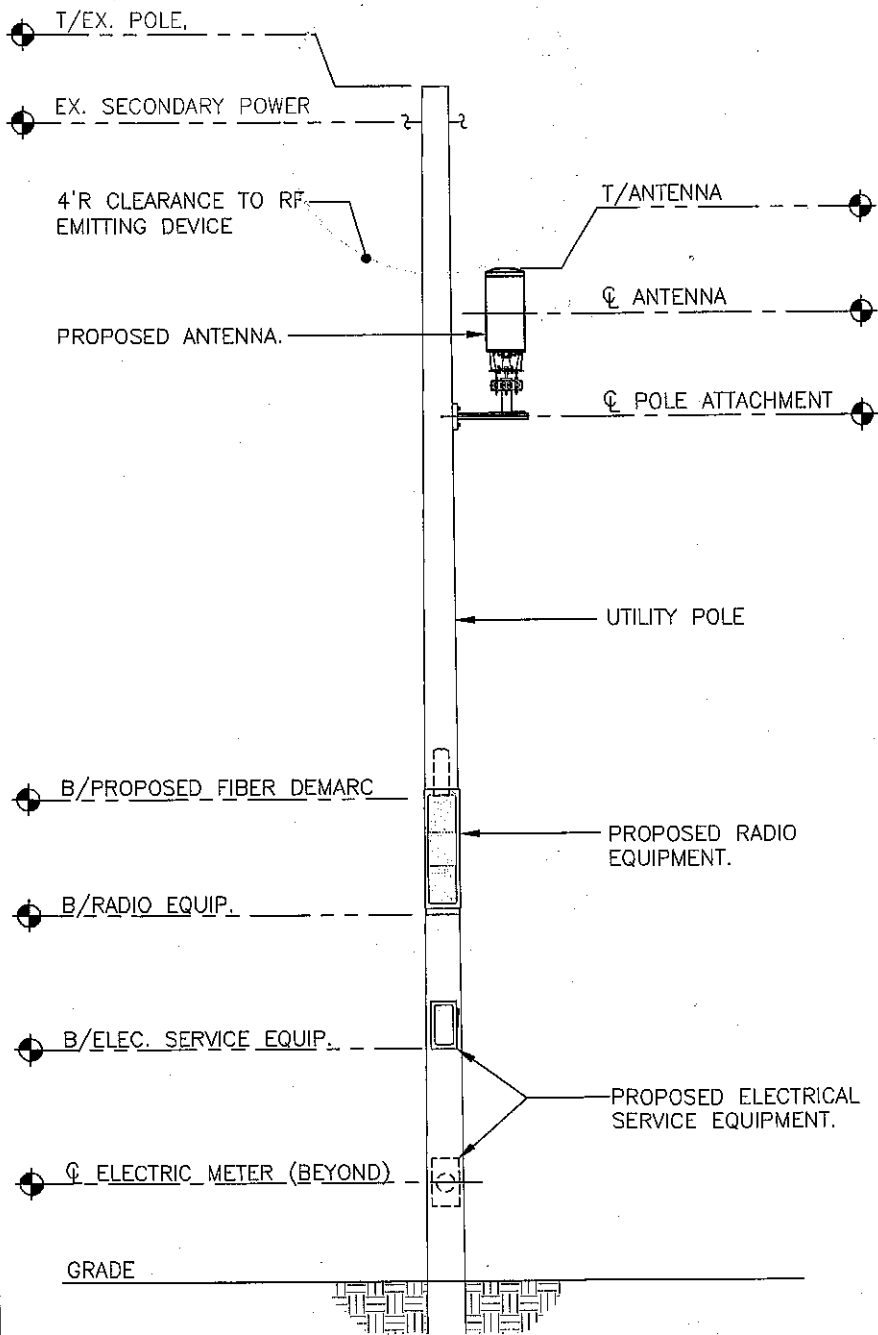

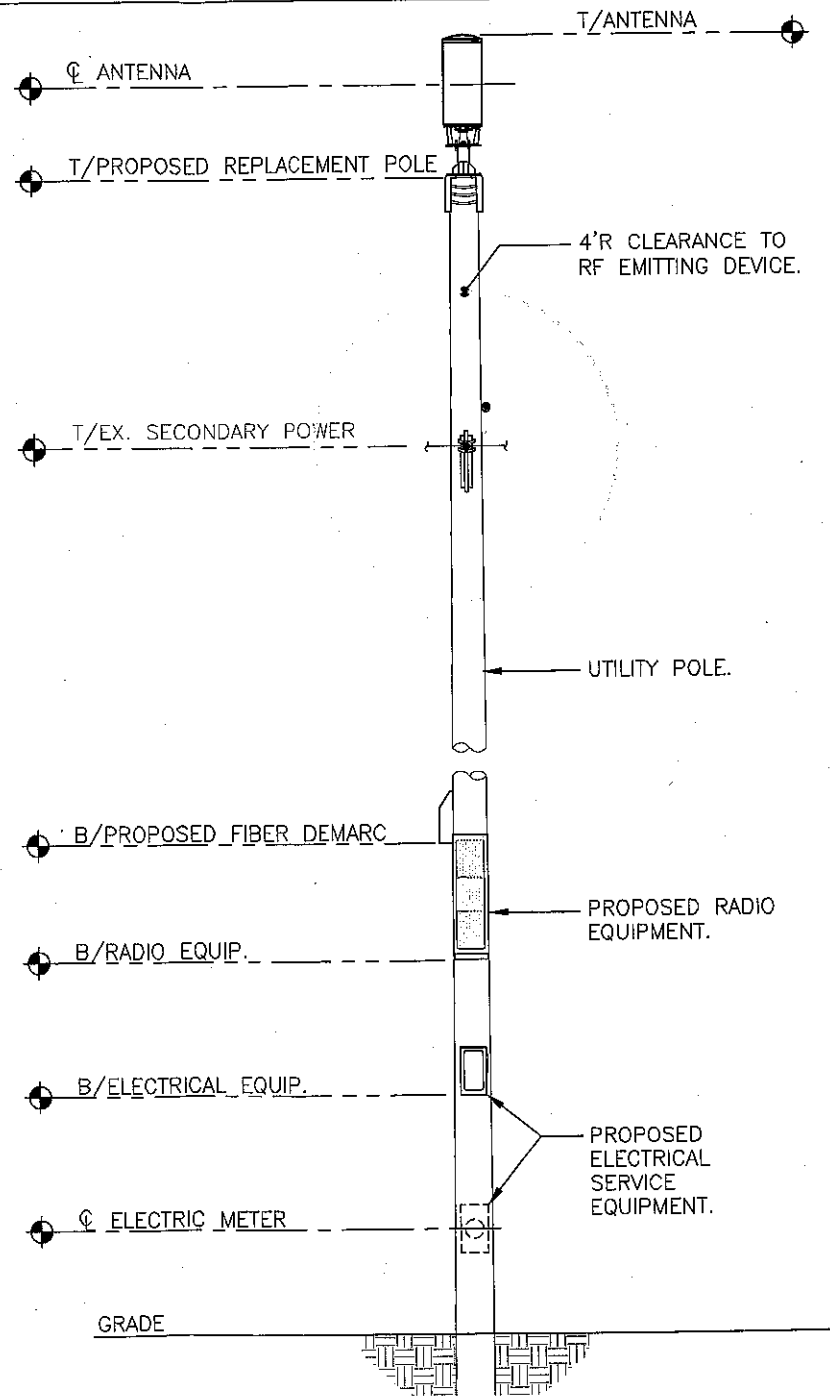
