BUS TO TRAIN

Metro North Railroad Shuttle Bus -

MTA Bus to Train Schedule between New Canaan and Stamford

New Canaan and Talmadge Hill Train Stations to Stamford Train Station.

For every train out of service, seven days a week, one bus will make all stops between New Canaan and Stamford.

Between 4:51 a.m. and 9:08 a.m. Monday – Friday there will be two buses for every train out of service. One runs New Canaan to Talmadge Hill and then express to Stamford. This is in addition to the bus making all stops between NC and Stamford.

The cost is included in regular Metro-North ticket fare from New Canaan / Talmadge Hill. Conductors will be at New Canaan and Stamford collecting / scanning tickets.

<u>Boxcar Private Coaches</u> – Talmadge Hill Station to Noroton Heights <u>boxcar.com</u>

The Town is working with Boxcar to possibly provide private motor coaches for the four out-of-service peak hour trains morning and evening. These Boxcar buses would run only from Talmadge Hill Station to Noroton Heights Station and would include Boxcar parking space at Talmadge Hill. Estimated cost is \$10 - \$15 per day. NOTE ON NEW CANAAN PARKING PERMITS

The Parking Department expects that the Town will extend annual commuter parking permits beyond the August 31 renewal date to compensate commuters for commuter lot parking privileges not used during the shutdown. Further action on this will be taken by the Parking Commission and the Board of Selectman in June.
