Connecticut Law requires that all dogs six months and older be licensed in the town in which they live. In order to obtain a license your dog must have a current rabies vaccination.

Dog Licenses can be obtained in person through the Town Clerk's Office at Town Hall at 77 Main Street or by application through the mail. A current rabies vaccination certificate must be included with your application (no photocopies, please). Once your information has been processed, a dog tag and license will be issued. Your dog should wear his or her tag at all times.

License period is July $1^{\text {st }}$ through June $30^{\text {th }}$. Licenses must be renewed each year during the month of June or a monthly penalty of $\$ 1.00$ will apply. Renewal reminder forms are mailed at the end of May for currently licensed dogs.
